- Project

On-Line

- What are you wearing
 - Makeup
 - Colors
 - Patterns
- Use of space
- Background
 - Blurred
 - Screen
 - Picture
- Lights
- Look at your camera
- Test ahead of Presentation

Do

- Introduce yourself & qualifications
- Know your subject
- Get back to the questioner if you don't know the answer
- Fit your speech to the time allotted
- Practice words and phrases
- Utilize humor, vocal variety and body language
- Prepare and practice

Don't

- Read the presentation
- Utilize words or phrases unknown where you are presenting
- Overuse slides
- Say you'll do Q&A and forget
