Three Main Questions

Everyone Wants Them: But Few Understand Them

1. Why do you want to integrate your systems?
2. How do we explain integrations?

What To Think About

 - **RFP / RFQ – get a long list**

What To Think About

- **Why do you want to integrate with Cityworks?**

Typical Response:

- **We just want them to talk to each other.**
- **RFP / RFQ – get a long list**

What integrations do:

- **Remove Duplicate Entries**
- **Alleviate Manual Processes**
- **Paper Copies/Reports**
- **Keep Data Current Between Systems**

What To Think About

- Why do you want to integrate with Cityworks?
- How do we explain integrations?
 - Integrations are **NOT** magic – they don't just “work”
 - APIs are only responsible for 1 side of the integration
 - The 3rd party – make sure they can do what they say – **DOCUMENTATION**
 - Exporting to any file is **NOT** an integration
 - Most integrations are **NOT** out of the box – they must be coded or configured
- What can our clients do to prepare?



What To Think About

- Why do you want to integrate with Cityworks?
- How do we explain integrations to Clients?
- **What can our clients do to prepare?**
 - **Think about how the two systems will talk to each other**
 - What data needs to be passed between the two systems
 - What are the integration points
 - **Talk with the 3rd party sales reps and developers**
 - Make sure they have documentation on APIs
 - Make sure you have the appropriate APIs or do you need to purchase
 - Can you or NewEdge code those APIs or will it require the 3rd party developers – what is that cost?



What To Think About

As Implementers – What We Have Discovered

- Half the 3rd parties do NOT have documented APIs
- 3rd Party is building the API on the fly
- Scheduling with a 3rd party can be difficult – extend go-lives
- When you find the right developer – store their information somewhere safe!!!
