Section I: Name Of The Organization

This association formerly known as the Texas ARC/INFO Users Group (TAIUG), shall be from henceforth known as the South Central Arc User Group (SCAUG). This being the official name as recognized by the IRS as a 501(c)(6) association (*EIN 75-2350019*) since December 1993.

Section II: Mission Statement

The purpose of the SCAUG is to act as an independent professional forum that promotes the sharing and exchange of ideas, information and techniques concerning the utilization of Environmental Systems Research Institute (Esri) software throughout the public, private and educational sectors among GIS professionals and other interested individuals specifically in the States of Oklahoma, Texas, Louisiana, and, Mississippi.

Section III: Business Location

The official business location of SCAUG will be the address in the SCAUG region as agreed upon by the current Executive Board. This address logically will be the address of the active Treasurer unless otherwise assigned.

Section IV: Board Members

The **Board** shall be comprised of the following thirteen (13) Board Members.

President, Vice President, Past President, Treasurer, Secretary, Conference Coordinator, Conference Coordinator-Elect, Oklahoma Representative, North Texas Representative, South Texas Representative, Louisiana Representative, Mississippi Representative, & Esri Representative

The **Executive Board** shall be comprised of the following five (5) Board Members.

President, Vice President, Past President, Treasurer, Secretary

Section V: Indemnification

SCAUG does indemnify any person, past or present, and his or her estate and personal representative against all liability and expense incurred by reason of the person being or having been an officer, board member, committee member, or carrying out affiliated duties on behalf of SCAUG to the full extent and in any manner that such person may be indemnified as such provision is legally permissible, other than the dues paid for membership. This proviso shall appear in all contracts entered into, by, and on behalf of SCAUG.
