The Oklahoma Corporation Commission has been collecting and scanning hard copies of aerial photographs for over a decade to aid the Pollution Abatement Department and Brownfield Program in creating timelines of historic contamination events. Being able to pinpoint the onset of a contamination event to within a few years greatly aids in the identification of responsible parties. Thanks to EPA UIC Special Project Grant funds and Brownfield Program funding, the OCC has been able to take a more proactive approach to photo gathering, digitizing, and georeferencing. The OCC's historical aerial collection has ballooned as a result. **These digitized and georeferenced photographs are being made available to the public for free as the final stage of the Oklahoma Historical Aerial Digitization Project (OHADP).**

This map has two purposes: 1) to serve as the current inventory of all the photo sets that have been brought to OCC staff's attention, and 2) to be a user-friendly conduit for the public to acquire the photographs they need.

Each is a list of existing photo sets for each county.
Every **colorful layer** is the footprint of a georeferenced photo set.
